**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE RUTHERFORD COUNTY AIRPORT AUTHORITY HELD AT THE RUTHERFORD COUNTY AIRPORT ON JULY 15, 2014 AT 5:30 PM.**

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**CALL TO ORDER/ PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Chairman Lovelace called the meeting to order and Vice Chairman Holland led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

There were no public comments.

**Minutes/June 17, 2014**

Julius Owens made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 17, 2014 meeting and William Eckler seconded. The motion passed with Chairman Lovelace, Vice Chairman Holland, Eckler, Owens and Richard voting aye; no Airport Authority Member voting no; and no Airport Authority excused.

**Financial Report**

County Manager Carl Classen reported on the revenues and expenditures through June 30, 2014. There were no questions about the financial report.

**Airport Operations Report**

Chris Roach reported fuel sales for the month of June were 10,744 gallons and last June totals were 6,552 gallons. He stated that the airport was hosting a Poker Run for approximately 24 airplanes for the upcoming weekend.

**Call Out Fee**

County Manager Carl Classen spoke about the need to reinstate the call out fee of \$50 to help with the cost of bringing an employee back after normal hours of operation.

Julius Owens made a motion to reinstate the call out fee of \$50 for after hour services and William Eckler seconded. The motion passed with Chairman Lovelace, Vice Chairman Holland, Eckler, Owens and Richard voting aye; no Airport Authority voting no; and no Airport Authority excused.

### **Mowing**

County Manager Carl Classen reviewed the current ground maintenance contract which expires on June 30, 2014.

Director of Solid Waste James Kilgo gave a presentation on mowing properties that are not under the contract, costly approximately \$6,064 and that consists of using inmate labor that is approximately \$280.00 a year, which would help decrease the expense of the ground maintenance in the next budget year.

William Eckler made a motion to recommend the budget amendment for the \$6,064 for mowing additional properties to the Board of Commissioners and Julius Owens seconded. The motion passed with Chairman Lovelace, Vice Chairman Holland, Eckler, Owens and Richard voting aye; no Airport Authority voting no; and no Airport Authority excused.

### **Hours of Operation**

County Manager Carl Classen discussed changing the hours of operation to Monday-Sunday from 9am to 6pm beginning September 1, 2014 to improve public service and minimize overtime/comp time costs.

County Manager Carl Classen stated that a budget amendment to part time salaries for \$5,000 would need to be applied for the additional monies to cover the hours for part time employees instead of comp time for the full time employee.

Julius Owens made a motion to recommend the budget amendment for the \$5,000 for part time salaries to the Board of Commissioners and William Eckler seconded. The motion passed with Chairman Lovelace, Vice Chairman Holland, Eckler, and Owens voting aye; Airport Authority Member Richard voting no; and no Airport Authority excused.

### **Declaration of Surplus Property**

County Manager Carl Classen recommended putting the former Owens house up for bid to be sold moved, and property graded. Roger Richard questioned if there was a motion for this request recently.

Roger Richard made a motion to delay the vote until after the closed session and Julius Owens seconded. The motion passed with Chairman Lovelace, Vice Chairman Holland, Eckler, Owens and Richard voting aye; no Airport Authority voting no; and no Airport Authority excused.

William Eckler mentioned the need to extend the runway to accommodate larger planes that are visiting the equestrian center in Tryon.

### **Closed Session Attorney Client Privilege NCGS 143-318-11(a)(3).**

Julius Owens moved and William Eckler seconded to go into closed session regarding attorney client privilege pursuant to NCGS 143-318.11(a)(3). The motion passed with Chairman Lovelace, Eckler, Owens and Richard voting aye; no Airport Authority Member voting no; and Airport Authority Vice Chairman Holland excused.

Carl Classen asked the board, Beth, and Brooke to remain.

County Manager reviewed the minutes in reference to the former Owens property and recommended to declare the property as surplus and place up for bid to be sold and moved.


