About the Rutherford County Farmers Market

The Rutherford County Farmers Market opened on June 20, 1975 as a marketing vehicle for local agricultural products. This year marks its 40th year of serving Rutherford County residents.

As part of a new venture in expanding the services offered by the Rutherford County Farmers Market, an *Indoor Market* will be operating this year in extending shopping opportunities during the week.

The *Indoor Farmers Market* is located at 108 W. Main Street in Forest City, and will be open on Friday and Saturday afternoons from 3-7 p.m.



Farmers Market shirts, tote bags, and hats are available at both market locations and through the Rutherford County Extension Center.

You can also visit the Market's open-air building located at 172 Depot Street in Forest City. Hours of operation for it are on Tuesdays & Saturdays from 8 am- 12 noon. Then beginning May 14th through August 27th on Thursdays, from 3-7pm.
