### **From: Rutherford County Offices**

**Rutherford County Offices, Convenience Centers, and Landfill** will operate on a delay on Tuesday, January 10, 2017. Offices will open at 10:00 a.m.

The **Rutherford County Senior Center and all satellite meal sites** will be closed on Tuesday, January 10, 2017. There will be no meal deliveries to homes.

**Rutherford County Transit** will run a normal schedule for operations on Tuesday, January 10, 2017 except for no Senior Center transportation, and passengers going to Rutherford Life Services will be on a one-hour delay.

All North Carolina Court Sessions in Rutherford County will operate on a regular schedule on Tuesday, January 10, 2017. Rutherford County Clerk of Court Office will open at the regular time, 8:30 a.m. The new jurors should arrive by 9:00 a.m.

Please be advised to continue to exercise extreme caution as some of the side roads, parking lots, steps, and sidewalks may still be hazardous. There have been reports of some black ice still present.
