CAMPAIGN SIGN REGULATIONS

Campaign Signs

- Per the Town's sign ordinance, campaign signs may be displayed no sooner than 60 days prior to the primary or election and must be removed within 5 days after the primary or election.
- No signs are to be placed on utility poles within the Town limits
- No signs are to be placed so as to obstruct a driver's clear line of sight
- Good idea to get permission from a home/property owner before placing a campaign sign on their property. Your sign may be removed by the property owner if no prior permission.
- No campaign signs are allowed on Town owned property
- NC DOT may remove any campaign signs, within their right of way, placed along state maintained roadways (within the Town those state maintained roadways are: Hwy 221 (Main Street), North Washington Street, Mountain Street, Ridgecrest Avenue, Hwy 108, Maple Street, John Smith Road, Edwards Street and Edwards Street Extension, Bob Hardin Road, Railroad Avenue, Charlotte Road, Industrial Drive)
- Check with Town Hall (287-3520) and/or Public Works Department (287-5961) for campaign signs that may have been removed by DOT or others
